THEORY PAPER – II, HAIR THERAPIST

- Skin Anatomy :-
 1. Structures of skin – 3 layers of skin , glands – sweat gland and sebaceous glands,
 2. lymph – meaning of lymph, lymph nodes on face
 3. Bones – of face and head,
 4. muscles – structure of muscles
Origin and insertion definition of ligaments, tendons of face and neck
Muscles of face and neck.
 5. Skin diseases– infectious diseases caused by bacteria, fungus, eczema, erythma, etc.
Pigment disorders like chiliasm, lentigas, freckles,
 6. Nail Diseases – infectious diseases – ringworm, onychotrophy etc.
 7. Nail Disorders – brittle nails, furrows on nails, blue nails, bruised nail etc.
 8. Electricity – conductors, insulators, types of current, units of electricity.
 9. Electro Therapy –
 - Brush massage and Cleansing – uses of machine, indications and contra indications .
 - High Frequency - uses of machine, indications and contra indications. indirect and direct method
 - Galvanic - uses of machine, indications and contra indications, iontophoresis and desincrustation.
 - Vacuum Suction - uses of machine, indications and contra indications, method of lymph drainage.
 - Ultra sonic - uses of machine, indications and contra indications.
 - Combining machine treatments.
 1. Hair Structure –
3 layers of Hair – cuticle, cortex and medulla
 2. Uses of Products –
Using styling products to enhance the look of hair cut , products commonly used are Mousse, Serum, spray

Facial –

1. Manual methods of Cleansing, Tanning,
 - a. Massage – Classification of massage movements, Contra indications.
 - b. Mask Therapy – Setting mask preparations and ingredients, non setting mask _ preparations and ingredients, contra indications
 - c. Manicure – caring for hands. Types of manicure – plain manicure, oil manicure, French manicure etc.
 - d. Nail work – cleaning shaping cutting of nails and hand massage , Nail paint application , contra indications
2. Pedicure – Caring for Feet , Nail work, Foot Massage, nail paint application, dead skin removal, contra indications, foot spa.
3. Waxing - removing hair on hands, legs, under arms with wax, side-blocks.
Application of wax, pulling of strips. Upper lips.
4. Threading – Removing hair from eye brows, facial hair with help of thread.
5. Make up – uses of make up products
Foundations – liquid, stick, pan cake, translucent powder
Eye Make up – mixing of eye shadow colors, eye Liner, mascara.
Lipsticks, simple make up sequence.
6. Bleaching – cream bleach, herbal bleach, mixing of hydrogen peroxide and activator
Application Techniques, taking Patch Test.
7. Home Care.

- Electro Therapy
1. Skin Analysis – Identifying
 - Skin type
 - Blemishes
 - Pigment disorders
 - Expression and superficial lines
 2. Brush cleansing and massage – uses of enzyme packs, application of brush and stone.
 3. Hi Frequency – direct method, sparking on pimples, massage with indirect method , use of n Powder and cream
 4. Galvanic Current – application of electrodes, use of tweezer, rollers, use of positive and Negative gel
 5. Ultra Sonic – application technique
 6. Pimple Treatment – complete treatment routine, extraction, sparking, use of infra red lamp.
 7. Combining machine treatments-
 - Desincrustation and vacuum
 - Brush cleansing and indirect hi frequency
 - Steaming and vacuum
 - Bridal make up.

1. Straight, U, Deep U, V, One length cut.
2. Boy cut

5. Scissor over comb and slopes
Using scissor and comb together on hair. ideal technique for short or gents hair cuts
6. Shampoo and conditioning – using shampoo and conditioners before or after hair cut
7. blow Drying – setting hair with help of hair dryers and various brushes
8. Color application- Cutting of foils, application of colour on foils and packing, applying colour on hair and root touch ups
9. Head massage – classical head massage, use of different products like coconut oil or medicinal or aurvedic oils, contra indications.
10. use of steam hood , vaporizers, hot towels. Contra indications.
